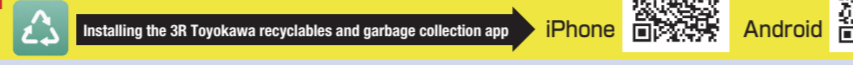

# Rules on Separating & Putting Out Resources and Household Garbage

April 2024 - March 2025

Put out garbage at the garbage station in your neighborhood between sunrise and 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. (Use officially designated garbage bags for burnable and non-burnable garbage.)  
Garbage stations are managed by each neighborhood association or management companies of apartments. Please refrain from discarding garbage in another neighborhood association's area because it will become a nuisance.

If natural disasters, such as typhoons, may scatter the collection boxes or nets, the collection of recyclable or hazardous garbage may be cancelled. (A collection day will not be rescheduled.) Cancellation will be announced on the city's website, the 3R Toyokawa recyclables and garbage collection app, and other means of communication.



## Recyclables

Once a week Every (day)

**Rule 1** Do not take wastepaper to the garbage station on rainy days.

**Rule 2** Separate wastepaper into four types.

**Rule 3** Bundle them with string crosswise.

- Newspapers only
- Advertisements, Magazines/Books, Mixed Paper
- Cardboard
- Drink boxes (Rinse and unfold).

**Put out non-recyclable paper as Burnable garbage.**

**Other types of recyclable paper**  
Paper boxes of sweets or others, Paper bags, Wrapping paper, Direct mail, Post cards, Business cards, Tissue boxes and Envelopes (remove plastic parts), Copy paper and so on

**Put out Old clothes/Towels** In a bag that reveals the contents.

**Rule 1** Don't take them out to the garbage station on rainy days.

**Rule 2** Dispose of torn, soiled, or foul-smelling old clothes as Burnable garbage.

**Rule 3** Dispose of cloth more than 1 m<sup>2</sup> as Large garbage.

**Do not put out papers, old clothes and towels, and white plastic trays on rainy days.**

**PET bottles** Crush a pet bottle before disposing it.

**Rule 1** Dispose of unusable PET bottles and containers of salad oil, sauce, and Korean barbecue sauce as Burnable garbage.

**Rule 2** Remove the caps and labels, and take out the internal content.

**Rule 3** Rinse the bottles.

**Rule 4** Crush.

**Metal items and cans** Dispose without crushing

**Rule 1** Trash that still has stains after rinsing should be included in the Non-burnable garbage category.

**Rule 2** Collected cans must be small enough to fit in the yellow wastebasket.

**Rule 3** No crushing.

**Bottles** (Glass containers for beverage/food, and makeup only)

**Rule 1** Remove caps or lids of beverage/food or makeup bottle containers and rinse out. (Put metal caps/lids in the wastebasket for metal and cans.)

**Rule 2** Dispose of unusable bottles as Non-burnable garbage.

**Rule 3** When you dispose of a 1.8-liter bottle, the cap must be on it.

No garbage is collected from December 29 to January 3. (For burnable garbage, an irregular or additional collection service will be provided during the year-end period.)  
In the case of natural disaster, such as a typhoon, collection of recyclable or hazardous garbage may be cancelled. (Collection will not be made on an alternative date)

**Collection of Recyclable Resources and Other Items at Specially Designated Site**

Date: The second and fourth Sunday of every month (9:00 to 15:00) ※Rain or shine ※Not collected on May 26.

Place: Warehouse on the east side of Toyokawa City Hall

Item: Recyclables and Hazardous garbage (spray cans, gas lighters, fluorescent tubes, mercury thermometers, batteries, rechargeable batteries, button batteries)

**Why not reuse unused items through the Jimoty regional information site?**

Let's reuse usable large garbage and other items through Jimoty! Toyokawa City has tied an agreement with Jimoty, Inc. for the promotion of reuse activities.

**Burnable garbage** Twice a week Every week (day)

**Rule 1** Dispose of burnable garbage as Large garbage if it is too large and the designated burnable garbage bag cannot be tied.

**Rule 2** Drain off all water thoroughly from food waste.

**Plastic products**  
The diameter of a bundle: 30 cm or less.

**Rule 1** Do not put them in a bag. Put them directly in the basket.

**Rule 2** Use them up before disposal. (Not necessary to punch holes in the container.) Dispose of the caps as Burnable garbage.

**Rule 3** Put them in their packages to prevent them from being broken (or wrap in paper).

**Rule 4** Rechargeable batteries and button batteries (SR, PR, LR types) can be recycled or collected by stores accepting batteries for recycling. Batteries (lead accumulator) are not accepted.

**Hazardous garbage** Twice a month Wednesday of every month

**Rule 1** Do not put them in a bag. Put them directly in the basket.

**Rule 2** Use them up before disposal. (Not necessary to punch holes in the container.) Dispose of the caps as Burnable garbage.

**Rule 3** Put them in their packages to prevent them from being broken (or wrap in paper).

**Rule 4** Rechargeable batteries and button batteries (SR, PR, LR types) can be recycled or collected by stores accepting batteries for recycling. Batteries (lead accumulator) are not accepted.

**Large garbage** Dispose of garbage as large garbage if it is too large and the designated garbage bag cannot be tied or if it exceeds a specific length or thickness.

**Bringing in Directly** Free of charge (However, a fee is charged for the disposal of the products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law.) No appointment necessary.

**Individual collection** Paid collection; you need to make a reservation by telephone. (As for the Products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, 2,100 yen and a recycling ticket per item are required.)

**Collection charge** 1,050 yen per item, in principle

**Collection day** Everyday (Except Dec.31 - Jan.3)

**Collection Time** 9:00 - 16:30

**Non-burnable garbage** Twice a month Wednesday of every month

**Rule 1** Dispose of non-burnable garbage as Large garbage if it is too large and the designated non-burnable garbage bag cannot be tied.

**Rule 2** Dispose of spray cans and butane gas cartridges as Hazardous garbage even if they are empty. They may still cause an explosion.

**Rule 3** Remove all removable batteries and rechargeable batteries from home appliances. (Bundle cords)

**Small home appliances** PCs are not collected.

**Small home appliances can also be disposed of by the methods described below.**

**Small truck rental for transporting garbage** fee charged

**Day for lending** Everyday (It is not available between December 31 and January 3.)

**Fee** 300 yen per time (includes insurance and fuel)

**Time for lending** ① 9:00 - 12:00 ② 13:00 - 16:00

**How to reserve a truck** Make reservations in person at Toyokawa-shi Seisou Jigyou Ka (Waste Management Division) or by phone (TEL 89-2166)

**Cancellation** After making a reservation and completing the procedure for truck rental on weekends and holidays, the cancellation procedure must be completed on the weekday before the reserved date. (Otherwise, the rental fee will not be refunded.)

**Purpose** Trucks are restricted to transporting garbage and recyclables from homes in Toyokawa City to the city's designated facility. ※Reservations for rental trucks may be cancelled due to vehicle breakdown or other unavoidable reason.

**Non-Collectible garbage** Please do not dispose of it at the garbage station
