


TOYOKAWA ANSHIN MAIL How to register for the service

TOYOKAWA ANSHIN MAIL is the E-mail service that Toyokawa City provides information of disaster prevention, fire information, weather information, foreign language distribution, and child-rearing information to your cell-phone and PC. The registration fee is free, but the packet communication fee and the access charge are required when you register or receive the mail. The alarm, such as heavy rain, storm, tsunami and so on, is automatically distributed when it is announced from Japan Meteorological Agency. This mail service is available for both your cell-phone and

This "International Mail" provides city information to foreign residents in Portuguese, English, and Spanish once a month. At the time of emergency, Chinese is also added.

- ①When you register your cell-phone address, this mail might be rejected because of your domain name designation. Set up your cell-phone to receive "city. toyokawa. lq.jp".
- When you register the mail address of your cell-phone, make sure that it's acceptable to receive URL mail.
- ③There is no fee required for the registration. But one is responsible for the data costs associated with receiving e-mails.
