Check ☐	●Payment of disaster relief money
Disaster relief money is paid to the household suffering from damage caused by disaster or fire. ※ Range and sum of relief money differ depending on the damage level. (Death or injury which requires hospitalization for further medical treatment, house completely destroyed by fire, house half destroyed by fire, damaged house temporarily not available for living due to flood above floor level, or sediment of earth and sand etc.)

Check ☐	●Payment of disaster relief money
Disaster relief money is paid to the household suffering from damage caused by disaster or fire. ※ Range and sum of relief money differ depending on the damage level. (Death, house completely destroyed by fire, house half destroyed by fire, damaged house temporarily not available for living due to flood above floor level, or sediment of earth and sand etc.)	
Check ☐	●Providing blankets, daily necessities
They are provided in case of damage such as house completely destroyed by fire, house half destroyed by fire, or house damaged by flood above floor level etc.

Check ☐	●Grace period for long-term care insurance premium (Kaigo Hoken Ryo)
In case of not being able to pay the insurance premium temporarily, collection can be extended up to 1 year by application.	
Check ☐	●Reduction of long-term care insurance premium
There are cases that long-term care insurance premium is reduced by application.	
Check ☐	●Special measures such as long-term care benefit etc. (Reduction of self-borne expense)
There are cases that the rate of long-term care benefit (Kaigo Kyufu) and prevention benefit (Yobo Kyufu) is raised based on the application (Self-borne expense is reduced.)

Check ☐	●Reduction of National Health Insurance premium
There are cases that National Health Insurance premium is reduced by application.

Check ☐	●Grace period for co-payment of National Health Insurance (Self-borne expense)
In case of not being able to pay co-payment (Self-borne expense) temporarily, collection can be extended up to 1 year by application.	
Check ☐	●Reduction of co-payment of National Health Insurance (Self-borne expense)
There are cases that co-payment (Self-borne expense) is reduced by application.

Check ☐	Exemption of National Pension Premium
When category 1 insured person itself, its spouse, or the householder became a disaster victim and has difficulty paying the insurance premium, if the person applies to the responsible counter of National Pension or to Pension Office, and the application is approved by Japan Pension Service, payment of total or partial insurance premium is exempted for certain period. (When the damage caused by earthquake, storm, fire, or other similar disasters to the house, household effects, or other property is about 1/2 or more of the value)

Check ☐	●Grace period for Late-Stage Medical Insurance for the Elderly premium
In case of not being able to pay the insurance premium temporarily, collection can be extended up to 6 months by application.	
Check ☐	●Reduction of Late-Stage Medical Insurance for the Elderly premium
There are cases that insurance premium is reduced by application.	
Check ☐	●Reduction of co-payment of Late-Stage Medical Insurance for the Elderly (Self-borne expense)
There are cases that co-payment (Self-borne expense) is reduced by application.

Check ☐	●Change of nursery fee
In case of noticeable change with the person's financial ability, there are cases that the fee for nursery school is changed.

Check ☐	●Special measures for Child Rearing Allowance (Jido Fuyo Teate)
For person with recipient qualification of Child Rearing Allowance who received damage and whose lost property is equivalent to approximately 1/2 or more of its housing ・ household goods value, there are cases of providing entire amount of the payment by lifting income regulations.

Check ☐	●Payment of Financial Aid for Reconstructing Livelihoods of Disaster Victims
Financial aid is paid to the household eligible for Act on Support for Reconstructing Livelihoods of Disaster Victims (National system) or Toyokawa City Support System for Reconstructing Livelihoods of Disaster Victims (Municipal system) among households suffering from damage caused by natural disaster. ※The sum of financial aid differs depending on the damage level. 1 Basic Financial Aid: Financial aid up to 1 million yen is paid as to the damage of the house. (Completely destroyed ・ Half destroyed house demolition etc.). 2 Additional Financial Aid: Financial aid up to 2 million yen is paid as to housing reconstruction method (Construction ・ Purchase etc.).

Check ☐	●Reduction of real estate tax ・ city planning tax
In case that the person is a taxpayer of real estate tax ・ city planning tax, and the eligible assets got damaged by disaster etc., the taxes may be reduced depending on the damage level.

Check ☐	●Reduction of resident tax
In case that the person is a taxpayer of resident tax, and received damage caused by disaster etc., the tax may be reduced depending on the damage level.

Check ☐	●Grace period of tax payment
If it is confirmed that the person is not able to pay resident tax etc., collection can be extended up to 1 year based on the application.

Check ☐	●Financial aid for credit guarantee fee regarding “Disaster Measures Fund (Saigai Taio Shikin)” of Aichi Prefecture Loan System
For person of small and medium-sized enterprise whose principal business operation site is located in Toyokawa city and who used the loan of “Disaster Measures Fund” by Aichi Prefecture Loan System, financial aid is applied for partial credit guarantee fee.

Check ☐	●Reduction of the fee for general waste disposal
Among household goods occurring from the house damaged by fire or disaster etc., things which meet certain conditions are eligible for reduction of disposal fee when they are brought in city's disposal facilities.

Check ☐	●Temporary move-in to Municipal Housing
For person who lost housing due to disaster, temporary move-in to Municipal Housing (Shiei Jutaku) is available if there are vacant rooms and the person meets certain conditions (Up to 3 months).

Check ☐	●Distribution of school textbooks etc.
For students who go to elementary and junior high schools in Toyokawa city, the system of re-distribution of school textbooks and supplementary readers may be available.	
Check ☐	●Subsidy for school lunch and school supplies etc.
If it is confirmed that the child is in difficult financial situation for schooling due to death of its guardian etc., there are cases that the child can get subsidy for school lunch and school supplies etc.

Check ☐	●Support for mental and physical health after receiving damage caused by disaster etc.
It is common that change of mental and physical conditions occurs after receiving damage. Specialist such as public health nurse can consult for the person.

Check ☐	●Lending welfare fund for living
In case that house or household goods were damaged by fire or storm and flood, welfare fund may be available for the expense of purchasing household goods or repairing etc. ※There are income regulations.

Check ☐	●Issuance of Certificates
【Issuance of Disaster Victim Certificate】 Application for respective support system requires Disaster Victim Certificate in many cases. Disaster Victim Certificate is a certificate which is issued based on the facts confirmed by municipality's inspection of damage condition. It is municipal clerical work prescribed on Disaster Countermeasures Basic Act article 90 paragraph 2 or Local Autonomy Act article 2. The document is to certify the damage level which is necessary to receive aid of respective support system for disaster victim. Place of application differs.
