# Household Garbage/Recyclables Collection Calendar

### Items accepted at the garbage station

#### Burnable garbage

Twice a week  
Every week

Use specified burnable garbage bags (red)

Rule 1 Dispose of burnable garbage as **Large garbage** if it is too large and the designated **burnable garbage bag** cannot be tied.

Rule 2 **Drain off** all water thoroughly from food waste.

Plastic products

- Long items such as hoses and ropes. Cut them into 1 meter lengths or shorter.
- Trimmed branches (Garden trees and shrubs)
  - You are allowed to dispose of pruned branches by cutting and tying them in small bundles as shown in the picture.
  - Dispose of branches with a diameter of 10-30 cm up to 1.5 m in length as **Large garbage**.

Food waste

- Styrofoam (Cut into size to be small enough for a designated garbage bag.)
- Leather and rubber products
- Torn, dirty, or foul-smelling clothing

#### Hazardous garbage

Twice a month  
Wednesday of every month

In the gray wastebasket

Rule 1 **Do not put them in a bag.** Put them directly in the basket.

Rule 2 Use them up before disposal. (Not necessary to punch holes in the container.) **Dispose of the caps as Burnable garbage.**

Rule 3 Put them in their packages to prevent them from being broken (or wrap in paper.)

Rule 4

- Batteries
- Rechargeable batteries
- Button batteries
- Power banks (not swollen)

Rechargeable batteries and button batteries (SR, PR, LR types) can be recycled or collected by stores accepting batteries for recycling. Car batteries and other lead accumulators are not accepted.

#### Non-burnable garbage

Twice a month  
Wednesday of every month

Use specified non-burnable garbage bags (transparent)

Rule 1 Dispose of non-burnable garbage as **Large garbage** if it is too large and the designated **non-burnable garbage bag** cannot be tied.

Rule 2 **Dispose of spray cans and butane gas cartridges as Hazardous garbage** even if they are empty. They may still cause an explosion.

Rule 3 Remove all rechargeable batteries and rechargeable batteries from home appliances. (Bundle cords)

Glass/Ceramics/Edged tools

As for edged tools and broken pieces, wrap them in the paper before taking them to the trash station.

Small home appliances

Incandescent / LED light bulbs

Only umbrellas do not have to be fitted in a garbage bag.

PCs and devices with built-in rechargeable batteries (such as lithium-ion batteries) are not collected.

#### Small home appliances can also be disposed of by the methods described below.

\*Excluding appliances subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (Air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers)

Method 1 Place in a used-small home appliance collection box (free of charge)

- Appliances to collect: small home appliances that can pass through the opening (17cm×28cm)
- Location: Waste Management Division, lifelong learning centers (Excluding Kozakai and PRIO Centers), Kozakai Kifukan

Method 2 Bringing directly to a disposal facility (Free of charge, includes items that are too big for the collection box)

- Size that fits into a designated non-burnable garbage bag → Sangatsuda Final Disposal Site
- Size that does not fit into a designated non-burnable garbage bag → Sodaigomi Uketsuke Center
- \*Dispose of PCs in a collection box or bring them to the disposal facility.
- \*If a device with a built-in rechargeable battery (such as a lithium-ion battery) is swollen or damaged, please bring it directly to the Sangatsuda Final Disposal Site.

Devices with Built-in Rechargeable Batteries (such as lithium-ion batteries)

Devices with built-in rechargeable batteries (such as lithium-ion batteries) are not collected at collection stations because of the risk of fire and other hazards. Please either put them in a small home appliance collection box or bring them directly to the Sangatsuda Final Disposal Site. Devices that are swollen or damaged must be brought directly to the Sangatsuda Final Disposal Site.

### Recyclables

Once a week  
Every (day)

Do not put out papers, old clothes and towels, and white plastic trays on rainy days.

#### Papers

Rule 1 Do not take wastepaper to the garbage station on rainy days.

Rule 2 Separate wastepaper into four types.

Rule 3 Bundle them with string crosswise.

Put out non-recyclable paper as **Burnable garbage**.

Other types of recyclable paper

Paper boxes of sweets or others, Paper bags, Wrapping paper, Direct mail, Post cards, Business cards, Tissue boxes and Envelopes (remove plastic parts), Copy paper and so on

Place small pieces of paper in a paper bag or an envelope and seal with string.

#### PET bottles

Crush a pet bottle before disposing it.

Rule 1 Remove the caps and labels, and take out the internal content.

Rule 2 Rinse the bottles.

Rule 3 Crush.

#### Metal items and cans

Dispose without crushing

Rule 1 Trash that still has stains after rinsing should be included in the **Non-burnable garbage** category.

Rule 2 Collected cans must be small enough to fit in the yellow wastebasket.

Rule 3 **No crushing**

Place small metal items such as paper clips and thumbtacks in a container such as a metal can to prevent them from falling out of the basket.

#### Old clothes / Towels

Rule 1 Don't take them out to the garbage station on rainy days.

Rule 2 Dispose of **tom, soiled, or foul-smelling** old clothes as **Burnable garbage**.

Rule 3 Dispose of cloth more than 1 m<sup>2</sup> as **Large garbage**.

#### Foam trays - White

Rule 1 Don't take them to the garbage station on rainy days.

Rule 2 Rinse and dry them.

Rule 3 Patterned / colored foam trays should be disposed of as **Burnable garbage**.

#### Bottles

(Glass containers for beverage/food, and makeup only)

Rule 1 Remove caps or lids of beverage/food or makeup bottle containers and rinse out. (Put metal caps/lids in the wastebasket for metal and cans.)

Rule 2 Dispose of unusable bottles as **Non-burnable garbage**.

Rule 3 When you dispose of a 1.8-liter bottle, the cap must be on it.

### Items not accepted at the garbage station

#### Large garbage

Dispose of garbage as large garbage if it is too large and the designated garbage bag cannot be tied or if it exceeds a specific length or thickness.

- Garbage is too large and the designated garbage bag cannot be tied. (desks, sofas, bicycles, large electrical appliances, golf clubs, bathtub covers, etc.)
- Branches with a diameter of 10-30 cm or within a length of 1.5 m. (We cannot collect construction waste or items that cannot be processed in the city.)
- Fabric articles larger than 1-meter square (curtains, blankets, comforters, sheets, carpets, etc.) and garbage that fits into the bag but is long (hoses, rope)

Bringing in Directly

- Free of charge (However, a fee is charged for the disposal of the products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law.)
- No appointment necessary.
- Please be sure to show your driver's license or other ID for staff to confirm that the discharge is from within the city.
- You are asked to unload the garbage you bring yourself.
- Large garbage only.

Individual collection

- Paid collection (Reservation required by telephone or FAX)
- Collection charge 1,050 yen per item, in principle (As for the Products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law, 2,100 yen and a recycling ticket per item are required.)

For collecting garbage from the front door of each household, contact **Sodaigomi Uketsuke Center (TEL 89-2174)**

Collection day ▶ **Everyday** (except Dec.31 - Jan.3)

Collection Time ▶ **9:00 - 16:30**

### Non-Collectible garbage by the city

Contact a garbage disposal specialist or the store where you purchased the merchandise.

- Products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (Television, air conditioners, washing machines, cloth dryer, and refrigerators/freezers)
- Automobiles, motorbikes and other parts (tires, wheels, batteries, etc.)
- Waste oil (oil, kerosene, etc.)
- Paints
- Fire extinguishers
- FRP products
- Agriculture machinery
- Agricultural products
- Electric appliances for commercial use
- Architectural/structural waste materials
- Large pieces of wood (Items exceeding 30 cm in diameter)
- Concrete products
- Bricks
- Chemicals (agricultural chemicals, poisons, etc.)
- Earth and sand
- Fire-proof safe
- Products containing fluorocarbon gas, etc.

### Non-Collectible garbage

Please do not dispose of it at the garbage station

A mass of temporary garbage

- Garbage in large quantities (those that exceed ten bags or ten bundles) from moving or foliage from garden trees that has been pruned may not be brought in to garbage stations. Please take the garbage directly to each disposal facility. → Burnable garbage, mown grass and pruned branches are **charged**.

Garbage from commercial activities and recyclables

- Garbage from commercial activities must be disposed of by the business itself or taken to a collector/hauler of garbage authorized by Toyokawa City.
- Garbage and recyclables from farms, offices, stores, or factories cannot be put out at garbage stations.


If natural disasters, such as typhoons, may scatter the collection boxes or nets, the collection of recyclable or hazardous garbage may be cancelled. (A collection day will not be rescheduled.) Cancellation will be announced on the city's website and the 3R Toyokawa recyclables and garbage collection app.

No garbage is collected from December 29 to January 3. (For burnable garbage, an irregular or additional collection service will be provided during the year-end period on Tuesday, December 29.)



Garbage Disposal Facilities, Recycle Center, and Sangatsuda Final Disposal Site are closed on days when there is a **Facilities Closed** mark.

Recycle Center and Sangatsuda Final Disposal Site are closed on days when there is a **Facilities Closed** mark.

Sodaigomi Uketsuke Center is closed on days when there is a **Large garbage closed** mark.

Put out garbage at the garbage station in your neighborhood between **sunrise and 8:30 a.m. on the collection day.** (Use officially designated garbage bags for burnable and non-burnable garbage.)

Garbage stations are managed by each neighborhood association or management companies of apartments. **Please refrain from discarding garbage in another neighborhood association's area** because it will become a nuisance.

### ★ Products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law

(Television, air conditioners, washing machines, clothes dryer, and refrigerators/freezers)

#### Return to the place of purchase or repurchase (as a rule)

- To dispose independently
- Purchase recycle ticket at your nearest post office.
- Bring the item to be recycled to the designated collection center listed below with the recycle ticket.
- You may bring the item to be recycled to Sodaigomi Uketsuke Center. There is a charge of 520 yen transportation fee.

#### Designated manufacturer collection center (drop-off location)

- Designated pick-up location in Toyokawa, Nippon Express Co., Ltd. (20-1 Miyashita, Shimonagayama-cho TEL 95-5150)
- Check the official Home Electrical Appliance Recycle Ticket Center website (QR code on the right) or call the center for business days and business hours.


How to reserve a truck ▶ **Make reservations in person at Toyokawa-shi Seisou Jigyou Ka (Waste Management Division), by phone, or online.** \*Online reservations cannot be made for Saturdays, Sundays, or national holidays.

Cancellation ▶ **After making a reservation and completing the procedure for truck rental on weekends and holidays, the cancellation procedure must be completed on the weekday before the reserved date.** (Otherwise, the rental fee will not be refunded.)

Purpose ▶ Trucks are restricted to transporting garbage and recyclables from homes in Toyokawa City to the city's designated facility.

\*Reservations for rental trucks may be cancelled due to vehicle breakdown or other unavoidable reason.
